Marlboro First Aid Squad Cadet Rules

1. Community service and college recommendations may be given, provided the cadet is in good standing.
2. Each cadet must maintain a C or better average in school. Report cards must be shown to cadet advisors each marking period.
3. Cadets must agree to keep everything that occurs during calls confidential, and only discuss this information with senior squad members and other cadets.
4. Each cadet will be given a key card to enter the building. It may not be used to get anyone who is not a cadet into the building. Key cards must be returned to the squad if the cadet leaves the squad.
5. Each cadet must be in EMT class by September of their senior year.
6. As a representative of Marlboro First Aid Squad, all members must uphold our reputation in the community. As a Cadet, you are expected to avoid any situations that may get you into trouble.
7. Each cadet must ride their three hour weekly shift as scheduled, in addition to their cleanup shift scheduled once every 8 weeks.
8. For Cadets to go on calls they must be CPR certified and have passed a rig check. The squad will provide both these services.
9. Cadet meetings will be held the second Tuesday of each month from 7-8 P.M. Drills will follow from 8-9. Cadets must attend all meetings and drills, unless they give the cadet captain an acceptable excuse in advance.
10. Parents must be just as committed as the Cadets. Parents are expected to understand their child's commitment and responsibility to the First Aid Squad.
11. Any cadet who needs coverage for any shift must call every cadet on the list. If the cadet still cannot find coverage, they must notify the cadet captain.
12. There is a **TWO STRIKES POLICY**: the first time a cadet breaks the rule they will have to make up two cleanup shifts within the next month; the second time a cadet breaks a rule, they will be dismissed from the squad.
13. Cadets must follow the following dress code at all riding times, cleanups and other squad functions:
 - Shirts with sleeves (no tank tops, etc.)
 - Long pants (no shorts or capris)
 - Sneakers with socks
 - No hats
 - Additionally, Cadets must wear a Marlboro First Aid jacket on all calls
14. All Cadets are expected to participate in fundraising and public relations events such as Marlboro Day and the Marlboro Soccer Tournaments.
15. At no time should cell phones be used on a first aid call.
